

### Landfill Rates

(rates include state, district & local fees)

#### In-County Rates:

Minimum: \$12.00 (up to 540 lbs)  
\$43.75/ton\* Municipal & Industrial  
\*(Includes \$4/ton Solid Waste contract fee)

\$39.75/ton\* Construction & Demolition

**\*Any CDD loads containing garbage will be charged \$43.75/ton. All loads must be approved and are subject to inspection for the CDD rate.**

#### Out-of-County Rates:

Minimum: \$12.00 (up to 540 lbs)  
\$39.75/ton for all waste

(Putnam Co. Residents must pay an additional \$5.00/ton Solid Waste Generation Fee)

#### **\$10 Fee for Uncovered Loads**

#### **Items accepted at addition charge:**

**Freon Appliances:** \$12 per appliance

Must be clean & will be inspected.

Appliances mixed in load & dumped: \$20/fee

**Tires:** (see enclosed instructions)

**Tires mixed in loads \$5.00 each**

**Concrete/Asphalt:** (see enclosed instructions)

**Backhoe Assistance:** \$30/extra fee

#### **WE DO NOT ACCEPT ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS**

Yard Waste\*\*Hazardous Waste\*\*Liquids

**Batteries:** May be dropped off on pallets beside unloading area—no charge.

**CLEAN METALS SHOULD BE PLACED IN METAL CONTAINER BY UNLOADING AREAS.**

### Tire Recycling

Guidelines & Rates

Approved 3-1-02

Certain size tires will be accepted as a separate waste at the Landfill. Follow these guidelines when bringing in tires.

\*Scale operator must be informed when you have tires before pulling on the scale. Tires must be clean. Final inspection of tires will be made at the unloading area. The Landfill reserves the right to reject any loads. They need to be secured but not covered.

EPA Guidelines is to only carry 10 tires per load or else contact a licensed tire transporter for hauling.

Prices: **.03/Lb** for all passenger tires 16” or smaller, no rims (approximately .60/tire). These must be brought in a separate truck to receive this price – no mixed loads.

**.05/LB** for passenger tires w/rims or tractor tires (Tractors vary from 100-300 lbs). Mixed loads of tires will be scaled in at this price.

**.075/LB** for semi tires (A truck tire weights approximately 100 lbs).

#### **EARTHMOVING TIRES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

Large loads cannot include any other garbage. If garbage or construction debris is found or if tires are not disposed at designated areas, the load will be charged at \$5.00/tire for 16” minimum; larger tires will be weighed and charged .10/lb

The Landfill reserves the right to change tire prices with market fluctuation.

### Concrete & Asphalt

Guidelines approved 3-96

Prices revised 8-1-07

Concrete & Asphalt are accepted as a separate waste at the Henry County Landfill. Please follow these guidelines when bring in concrete or asphalt.

Your hauler is responsible for informing the scale operator when you have concrete or asphalt before pulling on scale.

Concrete will be weighed and charged \$4.50/ton

Asphalt will be weighed and charged at \$3.00/ton.

Final inspection of concrete and asphalt loads will be made at the unloading area.

Delivery of concrete and asphalt cannot include any other disposable (garbage) items. Should there be any additional garbage or construction debris outside of concrete fixed to gravel or dirt, the load will be considered as waste and will be re-weighed at the scale house and charged \$43.75/ton.

All haulers are responsible for loading any garbage or other debris left at the unloading area.

Concrete and asphalt loads need not be covered.

**\$10.00 “NO TARP”  
FEE!**

In an effort to reduce roadside litter, the Henry County Landfill requires all loads entering the facility to be securely tarped. All loads not tarped, will incur a \$10.00 fee in addition to the normal disposal fees for the load. We apologize for any inconvenience and thank you for your cooperation.

**Directions to our Landfill:**

We are located on Co. Rd. 11 between L & M

Coming from Napoleon: Take 108 South to Co. Rd. M, turn left. Go to Co. Rd. 11 & turn right. We are ½ mile down road on the left.

Coming from Defiance: Take 281 East to SR 108 and turn left. Go to Co. Rd. L and turn right. Go to Co. Rd. 11 and turn left. We are ½ mile down on right side of road.

Coming from Toledo: Take SR 24 to SR 109 and turn left. Stay on Rt. 109 until you come to Co. Rd. M. Turn right. Go to Co. Rd. 11 and turn left. We are ½ mile down road on left. (SEMI TRUCKS SHOULD GO TO CO. RD. L INSTEAD OF M (wider road).

Coming from Fulton Co. Either take SR 108 south through Napoleon, turn left on Co. Rd. M to Co. Rd. 11 and turn right OR take SR 109 south to Co. Rd. M and turn right. Co to Co. Rd. 11 and turn left.

Coming from Hamler: Stay on 109 north to Co. Rd. L Turn left to Co. Rd. 11; turn right.

**Malinta:** Behind old fire station (Henry & Center Street) Glass, aluminum, newspaper, magazines, cardboard, steel cans, #1 & #2 plastics.

**Landfill:** Semi trailer at entrance. Open 8-3:30 M-F; 8-11 Saturdays. Glass, steel cans, aluminum, newspapers, magazines, cardboard, #1 & #2 plastics.

**Heartland Disposal Service:** SR 6 between Co. Rd. 7&8. Hours 8-4:30 M-F. Clear and colored glass; aluminum, newspaper, magazines, cardboard, steel cans, #1&#2 plastics.
